Something to Think About

Jesus stood among his disciples and offered them peace. Does your presence bring peace to your family? To your friends? What can you do this week to be a peacemaker?

The Story

While the disciples were walking along the road to Emmaus, Jesus appeared to them, but they did not recognise him at first. They recognised Jesus when he broke the bread. As the disciples were talking about this, Jesus appeared to them again. They were afraid and thought they were seeing a ghost, but Jesus showed them his hands and his feet. The disciples were filled with joy to see Jesus. They gave Jesus some fish to eat, and Jesus explained the Scriptures to the disciples.

The Scriptures

A reading from the holy gospel according to Luke

24:35-48

Then the disciples from Emmaus told what happened on the road and how they knew he was the Lord when he broke the bread.

While Jesus' disciples were talking about what had happened, Jesus appeared to them and said, "May God give you peace!" They were frightened and terrified because they thought they were seeing a ghost. But Jesus said, "Why are you so frightened? Why do you doubt? Look at my hands and my feet and see who I am! Touch me and find out for yourselves. Ghosts don't have flesh and bones as you see I have."

After Jesus said this, he showed them his hands and his feet.

The disciples were so glad and amazed that they could not believe it.

Jesus then asked them, "Do you have something to eat?" They gave him a piece of baked fish. He took it and ate it as they watched.

Jesus said to them, "While I was still with you, I told you that everything written about me in the Law of Moses, the Books of the Prophets, and in the Psalms had to happen."

Then he helped them understand the Scriptures.

He told them: "The Scriptures say that the Messiah must suffer, then three days later he will rise from death. They also say that all people of every nation must be told in my name to turn to God, in order to be forgiven. So beginning in Jerusalem, you must tell everything that has happened."

Close your eyes and remember a time when you were confused or afraid. Maybe you were awake in the middle of the night? Maybe the electricity went out and you were in the dark until someone brought a torch or flashlight.

Imagine how frightened Jesus' friends must have been after they saw him being arrested and killed. When Jesus appeared to his friends again, they could see that he was alive and he explained that he had died so our sins could be forgiven. The disciples went out to tell everyone the wonderful news about God's love and forgiveness.

A Picnic

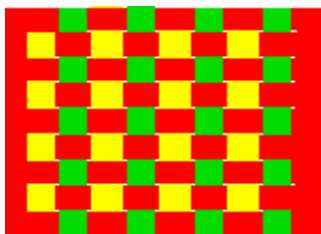
Jesus broke bread with his disciples and talked with them on the road. The disciples gave Jesus some baked fish to eat.

Today we are going to make a placemat that you could use at your picnic... or even at the dinner table!

Follow the instructions on the page below.

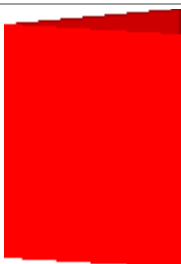




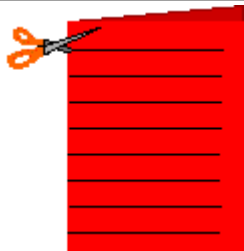
Make a Placemat

You will need:

- Three different colours of construction paper
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Glue or sticky-tape



Start with a large piece of construction paper.
Fold it in half.



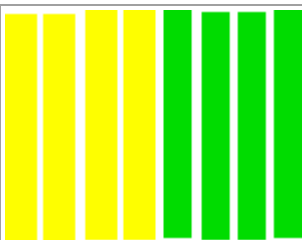
While the paper is folded, take a ruler and draw a series of lines across the fold.

Do not draw them all the way to the edge - leave about 1 inch at the edge.

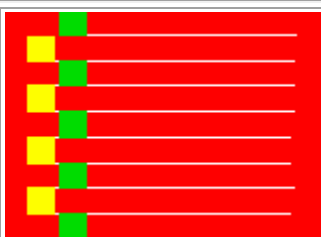


Cut along the lines.

Then unfold the piece of paper.

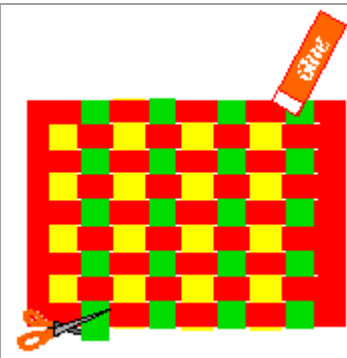


Using other colours of paper, cut many strips of paper about an inch wide, and the same length as the height of the original piece of paper.

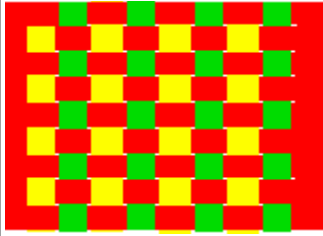


Start weaving the strips of paper onto the piece of paper where the lines have been cut.

Make sure that each new piece of paper is pushed up next to the previously woven piece.



When you have finished weaving, secure each strip of woven paper using glue or sticky-tape.
Trim the woven edges a bit to make the edges of the place mat look neat.



You can now use your place mat at a picnic with your family, or at the dinner table. Maybe you would like to give it to someone special.
